Loch Ness

After breakfast, we leave Edinburgh behind us for a couple of days and drive north, across the Firth of Forth and onwards to Loch Ness. Fort William

Signing up and payment

When your place on the trip is confirmed you will receive an email letting you know that you can pay for the trip.

Payment

When you place on the trip has been confirmed please go to:

https://tours.interstudies.com/payment to pay for the trip and secure your place.

Remember signing up for the trip is binding and there is no refund if you cancel. A minimum of 30 students are required for the tour to go ahead as planned. In case of InterStudies cancelling the trip, you will receive a full refund.

You should also remember to take out travel insurance for the tour – this is very important!

Wait! Please do not book your travel until we have confirmed your place on the trip and given you the 'go ahead'!

Transport

You are to arrange your own transport to and from the trip.

If you are under 16 you are not allowed to travel by plane on your own.

You will need to book together with a student over 16 in order to get on the plane.

The tour leader will tell you the best way to get to the hostel.

Don't book anything until you have been given the go ahead!

You must **arrive** on the start day of the trip and **leave** on the day the trip finishes. Travelling overnight (e.g. on overnight ferries or buses) isn't allowed.

Email your travel plans to us at least 2 weeks before the start of the trip!

Meals and accommodation

The **meals** specified in this brochure are included in the price of the trip. Other meals are not included. You will be able to choose where to eat yourself. Remember to bring enough pocket money to pay for your meals!

If you have any **allergies**, please let us know in advance!

We stay in **hostel style accommodation** in multibedded dorms on all our trips.

School

If the trip isn't during a school holiday at your school, you need to ask for permission at school before signing up. If you need a letter from InterStudies to get permission from the school, please email us!
